 acclaimed novels about two girls growing up in post-WWII Naples, Italy. This
 book was on the short list for the 2016 Man Booker International Prize.
- Thursday, November 10, 2:15 to 3:40: A Spool of Blue Thread by Anne
 Tyler (American). This finalist for the Man Booker Prize for 2015 is a family
